1 TRAINER COURSE

Complete the Google for Education Trainer Course (~6-8 hours). This course will provide instruction on 1) Creating and Delivering Inspiring and Effective Training Plans and 2) Helping Educators Use Transformative Google Technologies. This course will also help you bolster the training, leadership, and interpersonal relationship skills that make you an effective trainer.

2 TRAINER SKILLS ASSESSMENT

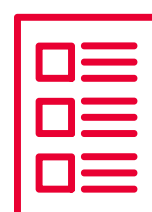
