PURPOSE & DELIVERY

- What is the purpose of your choice board?
- Where will this be completed?
- How much time should this take?

DETERMINE ASSESSMENT EVIDENCE

- What are your learning outcomes?
- How will you know when they get it?
- What activities will demonstrate mastery?

SELECT ACTIVITIES

- Each activity should align with one or more of the learning outcomes.
- Determine how many activities you want students to complete.

MUST-DO ACTIVITIES & FREE CHOICE

- Are there certain activities that you want every student to complete?
- Will you offer the option of "free choice" where student propose their own activity? (advanced)

SELECT CHOICE BOARD STYLE

- Simple list
- Tic-Tac-Toe

DESIGN
